

Dear Parents/Carers.

This term we are having a 'Learning Through Culture' week (week commencing Monday  $20^{\text{th}}$  November) focusing on Hull, as it is the 'City of Culture' this year, and we will be looking at what makes Hull so special, it's history and culture. On Tuesday  $21^{\text{st}}$  November we have planned a whole school trip to Hull which will be a great opportunity for children to see the city and visit some of the museums and galleries.

The trip will be in school time, leaving after registration at 9am, returning for the end of the school day at 3.30pm and children will be transported by coach to and from the event. To cover the cost of the trip, there is a voluntary contribution of £8 per child which is payable through 'ParentPay'. Children will not need any extra money to spend on the day.

Children will need to wear school uniform for the visit and wear a warm coat as we will be outside for some of the day. They will also need to bring a packed lunch. Key Stage 1 children are entitled to free school meals so can have a packed lunch provided by school. Please could parents of any Key Stage 1 child requiring a packed lunch to be provided by school let the school know by Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> November so our kitchen staff can order what is required. Those children who have free school meals will have a packed lunch provided. We will need extra adult help on the trip so if you are able and would like to help, please let us know.
