## SPORTING ACHIEVEMENTS

Sebastian (Y4) entered the South Yorkshire athletics indoor series held at Sheffield indoor arena. It is a multi discipline event comprising of a sprint, medium distance, jump & a throw. It is held over 4 separate events with the combined score from each athlete added to create a final total for that athlete. A set points scheme is allocated to a time or distance. If an athlete improves on the previous events time/distance their final total will improve. There are different age groups in both boys & girls competitions. Sebastian competed in the under 11yrs boys group aged 8yrs old in his first 2 events. With such a physical difference due to the age gap Sebastian did not win every discipline but consistently finished on the podium which ensured his points tally was higher than other competitors.
